

Setup Instructions

1. Uploading

- Upload the entire "importer" folder to your site using FTP.
- You should now have a directory structure like http://www.yoursite.com/importer
- The following folders should be <u>CHMOD</u> to **777**
 - o <u>/importer</u>
 - o <u>/importer/upload</u>

NOTE: If you get a server error when you load your site, CHMOD the above to 755

2. Custom Settings

Edit the file /importer/includes/config.php to change various setting such as:

- The email message that's sent out
- General email settings
- General site settings

3. Changing Themes

GetMyContacts comes with 4 themes. To change themes is very easy, simply follow the instructions below:

- Open the file /importer/includes/config.php
- Look for the section shown below and change the **\$theme_selected** by typing in a new theme name. The available names are given.
- o Example \$theme_selected = "blue-sky";
- o Save the file and upload it to your site into the folder /importer/includes/

//Enter the name of the theme to use //
// Available options are::
// grad-gray
// blue-sky
// lazy-days
// pretty-pink
\$theme_selected = 'lazy-days';

Using GetMyContacts

The importer can be used in various ways as shown on our demo page <u>http://getmycontacts.com/demo.htm</u>. There are 3 main ways in which you can add GetMyContacts to your site.

- 1. **Overlay** This is like a popup but much nicer looking
- 2. Integrated This is when the importer "looks" like your sites design
- 3. New Page A simple link to the importer that opens in a new window

Each method is explained in the sections below.

1. Overlay method

- Open the HTML page in your website where you want to add the "link" to the importer. You should use your favourite HTML editor or a text editor.
- In the <head></head> section of YOUR page, add the following code

<script type="text/javascript" src="importer/js/greybox/AJS.js"></script> <script type="text/javascript" src="importer/js/greybox/AJS_fx.js"></script>

<script type="text/javascript" src="importer/js/greybox/gb_scripts.js"></script>
<link href="importer/js/greybox/gb_styles.css" rel="stylesheet" type="text/css"
media="all" />
```

<u>NOTE:</u> If you have decided to install GetMyContacts in folder name other then "**importer**" then you should change the above code with your folder name.

2. Integrated method

This is probably the most difficult method and some good knowledge of HTML is required.

The simplest way is explained below.

 Select the entire contents between the <body></body> tags of the file named below. (note: depending on the selected theme the folder may be different)

/importer/themes/grad-gray/template.htm

- Paste this code anywhere in the **body** of YOUR designed page.
- You must now save YOUR designed page as /importer/themes/gradgray/template.htm i.e. it must run from inside GetMyContacts
- Now link to <u>http://www.yoursite.com/importer/</u> you should now see a page that's looks like the rest of your website.

<u>NOTE</u>: To avoid errors with images not showing, you should use hard links for your image references in your design e.g.

3. New Page method

This is probably the easiest method and requires little HTML knowledge.

- \circ $\,$ Open the page where you want to place the link to the contacts importer.
- o In that page add the following link anywhere you like
